- Building Job Search Skills such as help with applications, resume, cover letters, interview practice and networking.
- Career Advancement/Retention such as exploring your skills and strengths, getting your GED, help keeping your new job, short-term training, job leads, supported work experience.
- Supports\* Once engaged in an active STEP plan with a Provider. Possible <u>work-related</u> support payments made by Providers may include transportation, clothing, trainings and more.

\*Payment eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis by the STEP Provider in an active STEP case plan.
